

ASL Profile meeting – discussing comments

1. QIBA restructuring:

By the end of the year, RSA will stop supporting QIBA ASL profile writing. Efforts will be made to bring the Profile at least up to Stage 2 by the end of the year. As the committee is not only reliant to RSNA (EIBIR, and ESR sponsorship) the committee can continue its operation. Cyrus will approach the ASRM and Eszter will approach EIBALL.

2. Open comments:

Open comments are discussed in the second half of the meeting.

- Page 11, “acquisition protocol”: the word platform is added as recommended by Anthony Liu Ho-Ling in the comment.
- Cyrus Raji asks about what aspects are considered in the Profile. Patricia confirms that the the aim is to keep the Profile general, therefore the focus is on blood flow. Other aspects are not considered. Cyrus will write a suggestion for a paragraph to be added about the general focus on blood flow and why other aspects are not covered in this profile.
- Page 12, “Notes Header”: it is agreed to delete “enter on the console” and keep the text more general.
- Page 12, “Scan plane”: a separate section to be added on the position on labelling,
- Page 12: “Slice Thickness”: Slice Thickness was added as recommended by Anthony Liu Ho-Ling in the comment.
