- QIBA fMRI Language-Mapping Profile 2.0

#### Action Items

- While the fMRI Profile will be refined and finalized, it will not be advanced past current Profile development (Stage 0), i.e., it will not be disseminated for public comment
  - Clarification was provided regarding an activation quality control specification
  - Duplication between Section 4 Assessment Procedures text and Section 3 tables was reduced
    - Tables were thought to be more informative and text was modified to be more introductory
- Dr. Storrs made minor updates
- Adjustments were made to items in the “Assessment Procedure for fMRI weighted center-of-mass reproducibility table” which describes the steps for evaluating conformance
- Assessment of Claim language text to be removed
