## Discussion of Publication Options for the QIBA 3A Pilot Study

- The abstract for RSNA 2012 has been completed and submitted with Dr. Kim as lead author
- Parallel effort to focus on drafting a scientific paper for Pilot Study results and updating the Pivotal study documents
  - o Time must be allowed for an internal review by NIST prior to publication
- Group to begin working on sections of a scientific paper immediately as follows:
  - Introduction/ Overview/- 8has to be defined
  - o Integration of this project with QIBA A. Buckler
  - Statistics Dr. Kim
  - o Integration of section parts into a manuscript Dr. Athelogou
- Options for publication suggested were:
  - Academic Radiology
  - Radiology (possibly too clinical)
  - Physiological Measurement

## **Pilot Study Update**

- All participants will receive their own individualized radial plots
  - Results will be mailed to participants by mid-May
  - A 63 page report is nearly complete; however, review of the document by the planning group prior to release for the participants was requested
- Reminder regarding the importance of maintaining anonymity to preserve the integrity of the study
  - Pilot Challenge organizers to ask participants if it is permissible to include their names/ company names on the final public report/ publication(s) in order to acknowledge their participation while still maintaining their anonymity with regard to IDs and results
    - Competition with regard to creative innovation makes all of the participants sharper
