- Claim requires more work
 - o Information to support the claim and not more than what is needed to differentiate from protocol.
 - O What is the repeatability on the phantom?
 - o What is the repeatability on the patient?
- Issue image data acquisition: Scan FOV or focal spot size?
 - Suggested to replace with "field of view"
 - o Dr. Judy to work on the wording for this particular section
- Determination of what signal-to-noise" measurements are needed with adjustment to dose
- One Profile with various protocols as subsets rather than previously considered multiple Profiles
