Discussion topics:

- Review and wordsmithing of working CTA Profile (proposed 2023 version), using <u>Grammarly</u>
- Extension of Profile to include other pertinent areas for study
- Identification of target audience and application
- Introduction of a new assessment procedure for the multiparametric risk phenotype

Improvements suggested:

- Succinct definition needed for Intra-plaque hemorrhage (IPH); replace implication
- Use 'cholesterol' term instead of 'lipid'
- Replace footnote numbering with symbols to avoid confusion
- Consider longitudinal claims
- Look at all histology, not just plaque type
- Quantitative claim can be explained better
- Additional references are needed, e.g., "if you want to achieve a given accuracy, provide information on the prevalence of disease and distribution"
- Define categories histologically, as they may not be well understood, e.g., 'minimal disease,' 'stable plaque,'
 'unstable plaque,' etc.
- Explicitly state procedures so others can reproduce results
- Aim to have a common standard or benchmark
- Utilize tables where possible for ease of understanding definitions and quick reference

Decisions / Action items (ongoing):

- Field test may be postponed for current 2020 Consensus Profile until updated 2023 Profile is ready
- RSNA Staff to distribute the working Profile document to those on the 8/30 call
