- 1. Update on NIST Workshop to Introduce the QIBA Group 3A Challenge (Nov. 15th, Gaithersburg, MD)

- Each lesion has been tagged with a unique identifier
- Of these 97 lesions, approximately 34 are at 630 HU, which may not be optimal for certain algorithms/ participants
- Group decided to include the low density lesions to build a better dataset for future challenges.
