**DRO Project Topics Discussed**

- The DRO Project Questionnaire was reviewed and will continue to be updated.
  - The current questionnaire covers data transfer and analysis procedures
    - There was some confusion about versions – The current version is “V5”
  - Additional questionnaire(s) are needed to describe the DRO’s themselves
    - Questions to be answered:
      - How does one describe a DRO?
      - What is a DRO in respect to paradigm design?
      - How is a DRO structured?
    - A supplemental list may be created to include critical performance data:
      - Artifacts detected during acquisition
      - Acquisition problems encountered
      - Experience level of imager
      - Age of subject
      - Paradigm administered
      - Timing of tasks-in terms of brain area activation
- IRB input regarding the downloading of the anonymous data and potential differences between receiving DRO data vs. creating DRO data is anticipated by the end of the month.
