- I. Application and Data Submission Deadlines discussed for this Project/ Challenge
 - Advertising period: End of August through September 15, 2011
 - Deadline to submit completed applications for participation: October 15, 2011
 - Deadline to submit results of completed challenge: November 30, 2011
 - Group to readdress these timelines on the August 11th call.
 - Other considerations:
 - Use RSNA meeting to invite/ announce challenge for greater participation and international visibility
 - Pilot study completed with preliminary results proposed by RSNA 2011
 - Would like to complete project by the end of December 2011

II. Review of collaborative BBMSC/ NIST data portal (Mr. Buckler)

- http://dev.bbmsc.com MIDAS portal for public access to data from QIBA project 1A and future QIBA projects
- Mr. Saunders and Mr. Reynolds are loading subject description files for reference
- · Portal will contain actual imagery with study description files (imagery to be made public after publication)
- Headers include: image formation, seed points, results, truth data (synthetic lesions), etc.
- Analysis of variance for various experimental factors
- Mr. Saunders is working to fill in the spreadsheet on lesion seeding
 - o For each of the data sets, there are multiple lesions
 - o For each set of lesions one seed point will be provided to participants
 - Will use one seed point and one measurement per lesion in the pilot study

III. Registrar

- Objective collection point by an organization that is not a participant to administer the challenge, including:
 - o Drafting the various documents needed, e.g., the participant agreement and detailed protocol
 - o Posting to a web site to make the challenge known
 - o Handling the sourcing of data and collection of results
 - Conducting the analysis and preparing publications
 - Communications back to participants with regard to their individual results
- Two possibilities exist for Registrar: through Andrew Buckler as QIBA Program Director; and NIST, through Alden Dima as Informatics Program Liaison
 - During the meeting it was confirmed that Andrew Buckler and Alden Dima were each available to provide any needed support
 - o After the meeting, Mr. Dima confirmed that NIST is willing and interested to serve as official Registrar
