- Phantoms have been poured and cured and are 'resting' prior to shipment in the next two weeks
 - Both high and low elastic modulus materials have been cast; measurements are blinded for participants
- Dr. Lynch will ship all phantoms to Duke for preliminary measurement on one system to establish the inter-phantom variance.
 - o Adherence to individual manufacturer protocols will be followed, using the most up-to-date software available, and documenting equipment, software version, etc.
 - o Drs. Palmeri and Nightingale will discuss feasibility and a schedule for completion of the measurements.
 - Once measurements are complete, phantoms will be shipped overnight, to individual test sites.
- Each site provided an update on available equipment and current software versions.
