Executive Cmte (EC) Charter

- Discussion on strawman text, drafted by Mr. O'Donnell
- Text related to the Executive Cmte (EC) to be added to the <u>Committee Organization</u> Wiki page
- The intention is for the EC to have fewer members than the SC, resulting in a more efficient and agile group
 - \circ $\;$ This will streamline business and reduce the burden on the full SC $\;$
 - Monthly EC t-cons will replace the SC calls
 - o SC will meet quarterly
 - Twice in-person, including during the summer QIBA Annual Meeting and winter RSNA Annual Meeting
 - Twice by t-con in between the f2f meetings
 - The EC will be responsible for handling administrative matters and urgent issues between the quarterly SC meetings, and will have decision-making ability for non-complex items
 - With the smaller EC group, ad hoc meetings will be more easily scheduled so that time-sensitive issues can be addressed more effectively
- The EC will be composed of: SC Chair and Vice-chair (QIBA Co-chairs as of Nov 1), a representative from each modality Coordinating Cmte, Process Cmte Chair, Sustainability Interest Group Chair, Metrology Cmte Chair, External Relations Liaison, NCI/QIN Liaison. SC members may choose to attend as guests
 - When individuals are not available to attend a meeting, alternate representatives may be designated to attend
 - Mr. O'Donnell to send a proposed motion to the SC, that the Multi-parametric Task Force be upgraded to the Metrology Cmte once its current tasks are completed; Dr. Guimaraes indicated support for this idea
 - After some deliberation, it was agreed that the NCI/QIN Liaison (Dr. Nordstrom) should remain an explicitly named member as proposed, as should the External Relations Liaison (Dr. Sullivan)
 - o Designating an RSNA staff member as an official EC member was deemed appropriate
 - o It was proposed that EC meeting discussion be based on topics that are universal across modalities
- To ensure alignment across modality QIBA Kiosk posters, it was suggested that poster content be discussed during the Oct. EC meeting
- The goal is that the SC meetings will be more efficient as a result of the smaller EC's support
 - o It was cautioned that duplicate discussions during SC and EC meetings should be avoided
- Mr. O'Donnell to submit the change proposal draft to RSNA staff for EC review in October

Onboarding Process

- Recently-drafted introductory stakeholder-specific pages were reviewed
- Standardized template used, stating the QIBA mission and its purpose, with stakeholder-targeted introduction text, i.e., information and perspective most relevant/engaging to the individual
- The specific stakeholder's role in QIBA was explained and key value/benefits of QIBA were listed
- While the introductory stakeholder pages are intended to be high-level, they will evolve over time to contain links to pages containing information related to specific QIBA concepts (e.g., checklists)
- The <u>Process Cmte QIBA Wiki page</u> contains a link to the <u>QIBA for Imaging vendors</u> Wiki page drafted by Mr. O'Donnell, which is being used as a template
- There was a brief overview of the <u>QIBA for Statisticians</u>
- Additional material for the previously-reviewed **QIBA for Technologists** stakeholder page was shared
- A few stakeholder pages still need to be drafted:
 - o QIBA for Physicists (Dr. Jackson)
 - Analysis SW vendors/developers (Dr. Elsinger)
 - o Researchers/clinical trialists/pharma (Dr. Zahlmann)
 - Core lab (Dr. Cole)
