- DSC-MRI Profile to undergo maintenance update
 - o ROI size to be reduced to 2x2cm² to align with methods in the Prah article, on which Claims are based
 - All other minor changes to be highlighted in the Profile and commentary to be provided for BC voting member review and approval
 - o MR CC voting member review and approval to follow
 - Clean, updated version of Profile to be posted to QIBA Wiki DSC-MRI Committee page
- Dr. Shiroishi to reach out to Drs. Boxerman and Schmainda (GABLE Trial PIs) regarding the development of a checklist based on the DSC-MRI Profile, but adapted for use by clinical trial sites
 - o Checklist to include the following specifications: (1) 1.5 T Claims, (2) flip angles < 90 degrees, (3) no preload
 - Ms. Cimino, imaging technologist, to provide practical input
