## Final Group Review of the DCE-MRI Profile and Plans for Upcoming DCE-MRI BC Calls

- A final Profile internal BC review by Drs. Boss, Guimaraes and Rosen was completed, and recommended revisions were incorporated into the final Stage 1: Public Comment Profile
- Drs. Laue and Russek to follow up offline re: the NIST phantom library; contact details are needed for the Profile
- There was consensus among DCE-MRI BC members to skip the next two t-cons while the BC and CC votes-to-release are underway; the group planned to reconvene on November 23
- Staff confirmed that there was no QIBA Kiosk presence during this year's RSNA Virtual Annual Meeting, so
  groups would not need time to develop posters

- RSNA Staff to circulate an email to BC members with <u>voting privileges</u> to obtain approval (vote-to-release) that the content of the Profile meets the <u>criteria</u> for Stage 1: Public Comment
  - o The email will contain a link to the ballot and the lined, PDF Profile version will be attached
  - Voting members will be asked verify whether this Profile conforms to <u>Profile Guidelines</u>, and is of sufficient quality to release for public comment
  - The ballot period is typically ~2 weeks to allow time to review the full Profile text
  - BC members without voting privileges will be informed that the Profile has entered the approval stages for public comment
  - o An MR CC vote will follow
