## **Next Steps / Action Items:**

- Whole body DWI experts met Dr. Boss at ISMRM, suggesting forming a new BC committee relating to tumor volume and ADC biomarkers; leaders for these initiatives to be confirmed
  - New biomarker selection process/criteria: https://qibawiki.rsna.org/index.php/Selection Process
- The VERDICT team met w/ Dr. Boss and Dr. Malyarenko @ ISMRM and informed of open access for PROMISE Study (large scale multisite multiparametric prostate study including perfusion and ADC)
  - After mpMRI, 4mm-grid biopsies (~30) were conducted to confirm lesion status
  - Images and biopsy results will be available to anyone interested in reanalyzing the data by contacting Rosemary Clow: r.clow@ucl.ac.uk
- The DWI Technical Confirmation Task Force has reached consensus on all comments and changes continue to be incorporated into the Profile
- Some checklists have been combined and shortened and Dr. Boss to update specification tables in the Profile
- Access to the Google Sheet of site feasibility/test feedback can be requested from Dr. Boss
- The Google Doc outline of the white paper was reviewed; Drs. Andrews and Bercha to contribute to this effort and will contact Dr. Boss for access (Dr. Malyarenko tried sharing invites with them during the meeting)
- QIBA is asked to advise on quantitative quality assessment of prostate DWI to help PIRADS in their effort to develop a quantitative metric; consider inviting groups with image registration expertise (e.g., UWIsc, QIN) to derive quality metrics from DWI registration to T2
- Consensus to utilize monthly DWI BC timeslots for short updates with most work to be done offline between meetings
- Dr. Boss to finish incorporating changes into the Profile, request BC internal review of implemented resolutions before the June 15 meeting, and initiate a BC vote
- Following a successful DWI BC vote to publish the Profile as TC, focus will shift to the white paper
