 - Dr. Boutin to focus mainly on 3.4: Subject Selection

 - o Overall document review from a clinical and physics perspective Drs. Botto-van Bemden and Kogan
 - Appendices Dr. Wyatt

- Potential conflicts of interest will be discussed during the August 24 meeting
- Any remaining issues found during MSK BC internal review will be resolved and the Profile will be fine-tuned in response to feedback; final changes will be reviewed during the August 24 meeting
- After internal BC review has been completed and the public comment resolutions document has been finalized and wiki posted, an MSK BC vote-to-publish as Stage 2: Consensus will be initiated by email ballot
- An MR CC vote will follow a successful MSK BC vote
- MSK Consensus Profile and Comment Resolutions document to be published by the end of September
- Planning for <u>Stage 3: Technically Confirmed</u> will ensue; details can be found on the <u>Technical Confirmation Process</u> page of the QIBA Wiki
 - \circ $\;$ $\;$ Three or more sites to field test the Profile to be recruited
 - o <u>Technical Confirmation to be planned and coordinated</u>
 - o <u>Feedback to be collected from sites and resolved</u> based on their experience using the Profile
 - o Technically Confirmed Profile to be <u>reviewed</u>, approved, and <u>published</u>
- No QIBA BC has reached Stage 4: Claim Confirmed, which is more rigorous than Stage 3: Technically Confirmed; Process Committee discussion of details and procedures for these stages is underway
