Comparative Algorithm Study update:

- 13 participants signed up for the comparative study: 7 academic and 6 commercial
- Dr. Hatt has completed a QA beta test of the data and everything is working properly
- Detailed instructions to participate, including data download and results reporting, are being prepared
- Anticipated timeline for study completion is 2 months after instructions are distributed

Harmonization field testing (Dr. Humphries):

- Five sites have returned phantom scans and Dr. Humphries is evaluating the data and working on finalizing results
- Focus is on corrections to retrospective COPDGene study data
- Drs. Humphries and Obuchowski need clarification from Dr. Chen-Mayer regarding the proposed single model
- Goal is to present an interim analysis by RSNA 2017

- Dr. Fain is compiling feedback
- Once internal review is complete, a BC <u>vote by email ballot</u> will be needed to release the Profile for public comment per the <u>Profile Process</u> outlined by the Process Committee
