Comparative Study Update

- Nine participants have submitted data: four from academic centers and five from commercial entities
- Dr. Obuchowski's suggested changes to the analysis plan were reviewed
- The study is primarily focused on reproducibility, since a bias estimation is not possible without a reference standard, i.e. ground truth
- Dr. Obuchowski requested adding a reproducibility coefficient (RDC) and metrics to help support the claim
- Suggestions included:
 - o Providing confidence intervals for RDC
 - o Building a model to determine if certain factors affect precision, e.g. CT dose, lung volume, etc.
- The data are clustered and will be analyzed using Statistical Analysis Software (SAS) as well as Generalized Estimating Equations (GEES)

Profile Update:

- Mr. Sieren is working with Dr. Fain on the Profile offline to aid with incorporating updates
- March 10th is the goal deadline
- Dr. Lynch would like the COPD Biomarker Qualification Consortium (QBQC) to have access and greater awareness of the Profile even pre Public Comment if possible
