Topics discussed included proposed project aims:

- Aim 1: Tools for Profile assessment Generation of fMRI reference data
 - o fMRI datasets available for QIBA use and subsequent public access
- Aim 2: Multi-site comparison of existing fMRI analysis methods
- Aim 3: Profile optimization influence of specific methodological factors

Update on proposed projects timeline:

- If awarded, the notification of an NIH contract would likely be made by September
- To expedite tentative sub awards, technical committees are asked to work out project details and internal approvals in July/August) to be ready to begin projects in the fall
- No questions were raised by contract officers regarding project science or methodology, however, the possibility of 'phasing' the project into Year One and Year Two was discussed.

 - Current profile lacks specifics on how to achieve the reproducibility claims.
- Work to continue on the Profile to get it into a usable draft format.
 - o Should add detail on QA measures necessary to achieve claims.
