Discussion Topics

Letter to RSNA Quantitative Imaging Committee (QUIC)

Action Items:

- Review of letter to QUIC, involving efforts by Drs. Boss and Malyarenko (academics) and Drs. deSouza and Margolis (clinicians) which includes the following aspects:
 - o Interest in continuing DWI BC activities under the auspices of RSNA
 - ADC advocated for as one of the 1 3 QIBs on which QUIC could focus
 - o Focus on translatability and increased rigor of ADC as a result of DWI BC Profile efforts
 - BC establishment of formal conformance certification options for the Profile to support broad use and adoption of Profile
 - To further the clinical impact of DWI, the goal of the QIBA DWI Biomarker Committee has been to ensure the clinical adoption of ADC in clinical trials and clinical practice
 - Reference to Dave, et al 2019 paper, "Quantitative imaging biomarkers alliance (QIBA) recommendations for improved precision of DWI and DCE-MRI derived biomarkers in multicenter oncology trials," which yielded over 250 citations
 - Establishment of technical parameters and operating characteristics for prostate MRI (PI-RADS)
 - Intent to parlay the success of QIBA to develop a CPT code for quantitative DWI as has been done for MR elastography
