## **Data Analysis**

- Philips multi-frame DICOM format still proving to be problematic for VirtualScopics
- Dr. Ivancevic will reformat and export as single-frame DICOM data and resend to Dr. Ashton for analysis

#### **Profile Discussion**

Dr. Gupta reviewed proposed action items circulated on 11/17 in e-mail from RSNA staff

- Tumor size criteria of 2cm may be changed for different organ systems
- Suggested to keep wording as is for V1 and plan groundwork experiments to inform V2 of profile
- Site Selection and Qualification:
  - o Dr. Jackson to provide phantom specs and procedure for site selection
- Subject Preparation
  - o Minor changes to be made by Dr. Guimaraes
- Image Analysis
  - o Clarification needed from Dr. Ashton regarding expressions used
  - o Input needed on expressions used for SI ratios
  - o Dr. Gupta to follow up with Dr. Ashton concerning data analysis
- Quality Control
  - o Edits needed to make language more generic
  - Subject-specific quality control to be incorporated into Section 12
  - Dr. Gupta to ask Dr. Karczmar to review
- Imaging Section
  - o Dr. Ivancevic to review by 11/23
  - o RSNA staff to provide v0.9
  - Scanner-specific information to be requested from vendors for insertion at a later date
- Image Interpretation
  - o Dr. Zahlmann to send request to Dr. Knopp to complete this section
  - o If not possible, Dr. Gupta will provide a draft
- Risk
  - o Dr. Boyko to provide by 11/23

- o New ACR guidelines on Gadolinium contrast agents to be referenced
- All contributions to be sent to Dr. Gupta no later than 11/23

# **Public Comment Period and Trial Implementation**

- Drs. Zahlmann and Gupta to finalize text before v1.0 can be released
- Mechanism needed for public comment; suggestions included
  - o Corporate visits to invite company participation
  - o Committee members to disseminate to qualified peers
  - Invitation to post comments on Wiki
  - o Blast to membership from AAPM, ISMRM etc
- Steering Committee to discuss process at their 1/28/11 in-person meeting
- How and to whom authority is given to make final decision needs to be decided
  - o Rigorous process will provide credibility
  - o Input needed from Siemens and other manufacturers
