Discussion of Profile Issues:

- Mr. Sieren discussed the feedback and edits incorporated to the University of Iowa profile
 - o Discussion of breathing instructions and clinical application
 - o Debate on Scan FOV vs. focal spot size
 - Use of 64 slice scanner recommended, but consideration needs to be given to 16 slice scanners due to prevalence in the community
 - o Dr. Judy to provide additional information on phantoms, etc.
 - o Dr. Crapo to provide additional information on reproducibility and accuracy of measurement
- Profile claims not based in data yet
 - o Group moving forward to provide the necessary documentation through studies or additional groundwork
 - o Drs. Newell and Judy to review and select various studies in support of the claims to help finalize the Profile
 - o Agreed to use U.S. method for standard measurement in the Profile
- More information is needed regarding the precision of single point measurements to demonstrate change/ statistical performance/ correlation
- Goal to get the Profile out as soon as possible for public use; need to capture the most important elements at this point in time rather than delay distribution

Next steps:

- Drs. Newell and Lynch to collaborate on finalizing the claims to move the Profile toward the public comment phase
- Call for additional comments regarding the Univ of Iowa Profile to be sent to Mr. Sieren: <u>jered-sieren@uiowa.edu</u>.
- Mr. Buckler to follow up with Dr. Lynch regarding sample templates from other groups for wording of claims
- Dr. Judy to respond still with additional information on phantoms, etc. for the Profile
- Dr. Crapo to provide additional information on reproducibility and accuracy of measurement for the Profile
