Reminder regarding Year-3 NIBIB funded projects (Dr. Kinahan)

- Time to consider potential Year-3 NIBIB funded projects with focus on individual biomarkers
- Mid-March: 1st draft of application renewal needed; Early April final draft of application needed

Review of Profile Draft Status (Dr. Kinahan)

- Profile release deadline for Public Comment phase is March 22nd
 - Tech Ctte to review supporting literature and make any final necessary edits on next two calls (only necessary edits -- not margin notes)
 - Goal is to move into the Public Comment phase as soon as possible without delay of "wordsmithing"; group edits may continue in parallel effort
- Once Profile is in Public Comment phase, a dedicated "Profile Editor" will be needed to respond to any edits or changes in a timely manner during the 30-90 day period
- Would like a final Profile to be available by this summer
- Profile version with edits and margin comments will remain posted on the Wiki for reference:

 - Dr. Kinahan will incorporate all notes and edits for a "clean" copy prior to Public Comment release

- Dr. Doot suggested additional wording for "threshold of change" information
