## **Topics Discussed:**

- Philips 3T bug fix
- DCE-MRI Profile update
- QIBA Quantitative Imaging Data Warehouse (QIDW) retirement

## **Action Items**

- Philips identified a bug in their 3T scanner, and it will be fixed in release 12
  - This doesn't address the B1 issue, but they indicated interest in working with the DCE-MRI Profilewriting group on a future Profile version
- Remaining DCE-MRI Profile Tasks
  - o Performance issue related to Ktrans to be addressed
  - Statistical assumptions to be included in Claim description
  - Dr. Shiroishi to continue investigation into whether FDA clearance was granted for a power injector for DCE-MRI
  - Images of artifact examples are needed
  - References were incorporated into the Profile, which required installing PaperPile plugin, and converting all text back into a new <u>DCE-MRI Profile Google Doc</u>
  - o Appendix D: Abbreviations has been completed; suggestion to reference DWI Profile
  - Public comment submitter list to be included along with (1) Current Profile contributors and (2) Past and notable contributor lists

## **Next Steps:**

- DCE-MRI Profile-supporting research data in QIDW to be removed and/or copied and stored elsewhere as soon as possible, but no later than December 15, 2023
  - o References/links to the QIDW in Profiles will need to be updated to a new storage location
  - o Dr. Laue to set up a community in Zenodo, upload the data, and circulate the link
- DCE-MRI BC members were asked to review the DCE-MRI Profile Google Doc and provide feedback
- Completed resolution spreadsheet to be submitted to RSNA staff for Wiki posting
- BC internal review, and BC vote-to-publish the Profile as Stage 2: Consensus followed by an MR CC vote
