 - \circ $\;$ How to get fMRI ready for clinical trial use to be a breakout agenda item
- Discussion regarding grant funding (e.g., from NIH, etc.) to progress fMRI Profiles
- The QIBA Annual Meeting was deemed an opportunity to discuss next steps for language-mapping Profile v2.0
 - o Plan for constructing Profile needed
 - fMRI BC Co-chairs were encouraged to review the literature review spreadsheet containing language fMRI presurgical planning studies found on the fMRI Committee page on the QIBA Wiki at: <u>http://qibawiki.rsna.org/index.php/FMRI_Biomarker_Ctte</u>
 - fMRI BC Co-chairs to be assigned articles published within the past four years to review, take notes and bring to the meeting for discussion
 - Suggestion that fMRI BC members identify gaps in literature and devise ways for the fMRI BC to address them
- Less than optimal T-con participation is another topic for discussion during the meeting
- Creating Q/A standards to distinguish good-from-bad data using DROs was deemed critical for clinical trials
