Next Steps / Action Items:

- <u>Streamlined Profile Template</u>
 - Formal Process Cmte vote approved the new streamlined template, which will be posted to the wiki / publicized to Profile editors
 - Example text needs to be 'greyed out' in sections; Mr. O'Donnell to update for the generic template
 - Any cumulative feedback on the new template will be reviewed during Process Committee calls (open to all interested) and Profile Editor calls
 - o Changes to be considered (only if substantive and impactful) every three years or so
 - A Profile editors call to be organized (once monthly perhaps) to initially include some BCs in "drafting" stage at the end of the summer; Process Committee leaders to reach out to prospective group members via email
 - \circ $\;$ Two groups suggested to include about five BCs at a time
 - 1. fMRI, PET MBF, PEQUS (3 biomarkers within PEQUS) first call
 - 2. VBF, CEUS, DWI, CT Vol, CT SLN (Drs. Boedeker and Lifeng Yu) second call
 - Change log to be added to the appendix to communicate differences, e.g., specification, assessment procedure, Claim, etc., between two sequential versions
 - o After Mr. O'Donnell migrates comments, the template will be added to the <u>QIBA Wiki page</u>
 - Motion Approved: Mr. O'Donnell moved to accept the current 2022 Profile Template (once minor edits have been made), seconded by Dr. Petrick
- <u>Renaming of Profile Stage 3 Update on Survey</u>
 - o Thirteen QIBA Steering Committee members responded to the survey
 - As of 7/5/2022, the breakdown was:
 - Clinically Feasible Profile 6 votes
 - Field Tested Profile 4 votes
 - Tested Consensus Profile 3 votes
 - Joe to circulate test results to QIBA Steering Committee members; this will be discussed by QIBA Leadership and during the next QIBA Steering Committee meeting

Profile Maintenance/Versioning/Naming

- o Keeping the end user in mind is essential as non-QIBA users will not understand any coding or shorthand
- o Name of Profile, stage, and date were deemed the most essential elements for Profile naming
- Due to summer travel, etc., a final decision will not be made until the fall
- Dr. Boss urged that time should be taken with this decision to make certain a change will be for the better
- External Profile users / stakeholders (TBD) will be surveyed (with the <u>example lists of Profile names</u> and any new suggestions)
- Profile changes that might require an update included any change to the claim or update to protocols
- Naming of the Profiles is not equivalent to labeling the documents, e.g., change tracking and file naming
- The committee needs to decide what clarifying elements should be communicated with the Profile name
- Naming should be simple, digestible, and informative for the Profile more time and feedback from outside users may aid with this decision
- o Additional PC discussion needed before example sheet will be circulated to CC leaders for feedback

 - Work on planning editor meetings
 - Profile naming conventions
 - o Stage 3 Profile naming feedback from survey and input from QIBA Steering Committee / Leadership
 - <u>Estimates of Precision Guidance Text</u> discussion (if Dr. Obuchowski is available); Dr. Obuchowski to draft a summary version with key points for Process Cmte review
 - o <u>Coordinating Committee Profile Selection Process</u> topic to be revisited (review draft)
