Public Comment Resolution:

- Dr. Garra is working on public comment resolution and a conformance checklist for the Profile
- Dr. Garra thanked Ms. Alton for her help with editing the Profile, based on comments received
- 90% of comments received were from AAPM; it is clear that they did a thorough review, which was much appreciated by the BC
- Once comments have been addressed, Dr. Garra will submit them (in revised spreadsheet format), along with a clean version of the Profile, for posting on the QIBA wiki <u>Comment Resolutions Page</u>
- BC and CC voting will follow in efforts to publish the Profile as "Consensus" (Stage 2)
- Approximately half of the comments were discussed on the call; remaining ones will be discussed on the next call
 - Vendor and technical expert advice are needed to resolve these remaining questions

Non-Invasive Biomarkers of Metabolic Liver Disease (NIMBLE) Study:

- Dr. Garra mentioned that it is possible that the Profile may be tested in the NIMBLE study and could potentially attain technically confirmed and claim confirmed status
- The NIMBLE Study is funded by the Foundation of the National Institutes of Health (FNIH)
- It will utilize multiple modalities (MR, FibroScan, SWS) and vendors to measure repeatability and reproducibility

Action item:

• Dr. Fowlkes to follow up with AIUM admin staff to determine if a durable link can be made available for the AIUM guidance reference linked to the Profile
