MSK Profile (Dr. Link)

- The Profile was released on June 26 for a 90-day public comment period
- The public comment announcement was distributed to 1400+ QIBA members and 100+ society members
- Although no comments have yet been submitted, it is still early in the process; a reminder was sent on July 22
- Comments to be addressed on a continual basis instead of waiting until the close of the public comment phase
- The MSK public comment resolution Google Sheet will be used to document how feedback is addressed
- Once the MSK BC completes the following, it can declare its Profile as <u>Stage 2: Consensus</u> and it will be published on the <u>Profiles Page</u> on the QIBA Wiki
 - o Consensus is reached on all public comments
 - The completed comment resolution sheet is submitted to staff to post on the <u>Comment Resolutions page</u> of the QIBA Wiki
 - o Checklists to be updated and Conformance Procedures established
 - Successful BC and CC votes

Update on Special Report (Dr. Chalian)

- Dr. Chalian has been drafting a paper based on the MSK Profile in the style of a "Special Report," to be submitted to *Radiology*
- Publication of this paper is intended to:
 - Highlight the recommendations and Claims presented in the Profile
 - Issue recommendations for vendors to help standardize cartilage compositional imaging
 - o Communicate the required procedure to Profile users
- Dr. Chalian has updated the draft document in response to MSK BC feedback; statistical issues have yet to be addressed with Dr. Nancy Obuchowski's assistance
- Drs. Link and Li are working on figures for the imaging protocol
- Once the paper is completed (around Aug. 11), staff will distribute it to MSK BC members for review prior to submission

Multisite/multivendor Grant and Phantom - Update on Arthritis Foundation Study (Drs. Hardy / Link / Peng)

- Dr. Li received R01 funding to perform a multi-center standardization study, which will help with technical and claim confirmation
- The study team met to discuss logistics and protocol orders are ready to proceed

- The study is in the early recruitment phase; delayed due to COVID
- Patient scanning at UCSF has recently began on a very limited scale with spaced out sessions to allow adequate time for air exchange and sanitization processes between scans
