1. Tests of CIRS Phase II phantom samples

Kathy Nightingale's group at Duke tested some prototype Phase II phantom samples from the University of Wisconsin. These phantoms showed shear wave speeds consistent with the range observed in humans. However, the dispersion was considerably lower than the range observed in humans.

Kathy's group is currently testing the latest batch of phantoms that they just received from Ted Lynch at CIRS, and these phantoms are looking more promising. Kathy's group will have those results compiled soon.

2. Discussion of Data Acquisition Protocol for Phase II

Due to insufficient attendance by influential committee members, this discussion was deferred to a future teleconference.

3. Simulation Update

Mark Palmeri created a space on GitHub for sharing publicly-available simulation code. Dan Sullivan and other staff at QIBA are looking into requirements for allowing QIBA recognition of this software. Some code originally had proprietary information related to Siemens transducers. The code is being cleaned up in order to not to reveal proprietary information.
