The following topics were discussed:

Progress update on DSC-MRI White paper draft to be submitted to Radiology

Action items

- To reduce word count to meet Radiology submission guidelines, Dr. Wu moved technical detail to a supplementary document
 - Dr. Shiroishi to review the supplementary material and follow up with Dr. Fan, who was going to coregister images from another case
 - Example figures with smaller, potentially more reproducible ROIs sent by Dr. Hu will be included, as well
 as a more detailed discussion of alternate methods for normalization
- Discussion re: figure illustrating workflow, showing ROI placements and how to find the ROI in normal appearing white matter or in the tumor enhancement region
 - On Dr. Erickson indicated his preference for the 4 cm² ROI approach
- The workflow and normalization method in Section 4.7 Assessment Procedure to be updated for consistency with methods used in Prah paper, upon which the Profile Claim is based
 - Clarification to be added re: the ROI approach, noting multiple normalization methods
 - An additional round of public comment not required for minor amendments to Profile that do not impact
 Claim
 - o Edits can be made to Profiles between stages; the Process Cmte is working on nomenclature for versioning
 - Keeping track of Profile revisions for transparency to be discussed and Dr. Boss will follow up with the DSC-MRI BC
 - Discussion re: documenting Profile revisions and the associated rationale
 - The change log had been omitted from the streamlined Profile template to reduce Profile length and in response to feedback from the user community
 - Suggestion to add comments re: latest updates to an additional tab of the DSC-MRI Consensus
 Comments Resolution Google Sheet instead
 - Staff to follow up with DSC leaders to confirm their editing privileges for the public comment resolutions Google Sheet used during the consensus process
 - Decision made to retain the change log in the stage 2 consensus DSC-MRI Profile
- Dr. Shiroishi to finish summary statement, fix references section, and add key words
- Once the draft is completed, Dr. Shiroishi to send updated version of the white paper to Drs. Hu and Wu for review; it will then be forwarded to all co-authors for approval
