Dear QIBA Volume Flow Committee Members,

We are not meeting today. Sorry for the late notice!

The following is a list of updates for the group:

- The QIBA proposal volume blood flow has been resubmitted with revisions to address
 the questions and concerns raised by the reviewers. We are now awaiting the ranking
 within the ultrasound section of QIBA.
- In addition we have setup the Quantitative Imaging Data Warehouse (QIDW) section for our committee for exchanging and uploading QIBA files as they are acquired during the planned phantom study.
- Two manufacturers (Hitachi and Siemens) are in the process of establishing data export for volume flow measurements and we are working with them.
- Philips is in the process together with the University of Michigan to provide a dedicated volume scanner (with modified software) that will be shipped to participating sites with existing Philips scanners.
