IEEE Symposium Update

- The IEEE International Ultrasonics Symposium (IUS) was held in Glasgow, Scotland, UK from October 6-9
- Dr. Averkiou noted that there were a fair number of papers on quantification, especially with regard to therapy monitoring

QIBA US Modality Poster for RSNA 2019

- Emphasis should be on the impact of QI and showcasing (marketing) the work and benefits of QIBA
- The posters should be visually appealing, with more images and less text
- Poster slides for CEUS were reviewed for content and accuracy of data or statistics
- Some slides that needed minor edits were as follows:
 - Lumason (contrast agent) has been FDA approved for 3 years for use in the liver, and 2 years for the treatment of reflux
 - Global usage and cost of a CEUS exam
 - Dr. Erpelding to send a link to Dr. Carson from the ICUS website, which has a helpful table that includes radiology and cardiac CEUS coding and Medicare reimbursement for CEUS.
 - o No details are available for bias in using CEUS; this would be good to include
 - o It might also be of benefit to include what number of CEUS studies, if attempted, were successful
- Dr. Carson is coordinating and assembling the poster for all US BCs
