### **Discussion**

- The purpose of the call was to continue the review of comments and questions received in response to the Briefing Document sent to the FDA, in preparation for the August 31<sup>st</sup> BQRT meeting in Washington DC.
  - Drs. Sullivan, Mozley, Schwartz and McNitt-Gray discussed a forward thinking approach for Wednesday's meeting; the FDA wants to know what QIBA is recommending.
  - Confidence to come from strength of QIBA groundwork data in efforts to support future FDA mandates; a single context-of-use to be focused upon.
  - Dr. McNitt-Gray's slides are complete at this point, but he is open to the idea of referencing the *Guidance for Industry* documents, as well.
  - The group confirmed that the full data package will not be presented at this time. After comments are received from the FDA, the next challenge will be identified and the principles to do this will be more specific.
  - The VOL-CT Profile is in the public comment phase. Future work will need to be done to the Profile in regards to quality control, target lesions, and measurement methods
  - The FDA is aware of the process Roadmap and the project planning Gantt Charts; no slides or verbal discussion based on this material deemed necessary.
     Suggested was that several face-to-face meetings for QIBA, the Imaging Biomarker Roundtable and strategizing meetings be referenced.
