#### **Proposed Project Update for next round**

• Dr. Sullivan indicated that the fMRI project falls in the fundable range, although it is unknown at this time whether or not funding will be available

#### Template for special issue of the QIBA Newsletter

Dr. Elsinger is working on completing this and will send a copy to RSNA staff

### **DRO Project Update (Dr. Voyvodic)**

- Dr. Voyvodic has started generating DROs
  - The Round 1 DRO is based on empirical datasets of hand-motor and language tasks, where 'truth' is known, using de-identified forms.
  - O Using a script which can generate up to 19 datasets in a day
    - Synthetic data can be created by extracting empirical signals and adding them back into the datasets
- There were 5 testing sites from which all results are still pending
  - Goal to compare different methodologies for analyzing fMRI data, and to systematically examine Sources of Variance (SOVs).

### **Simplified Claim Language for the Profile**

- Dr. Obuchowski has provided an update to the claims template to include a simpler statement for nontechnical staff, as well as the necessary indices or detail within the body of the template for technical staff
  - Emphasis to state claims in practical terms and then provide additional supporting details
  - o Profile discussion to continue on next fMRI Technical Committee call.

Test sites to return completed surveys to Dr. Voyvodic; group to continue discussion on fMRI Bias call, 8/5.
