## **Profile Update:**

- The co-chairs are revising the current Profile to remove the proposed point-based conformance system (section 5) and simplify the checklist for ease of use and to encourage adoption
  - Setting the bar too high may result in lack of use, inability to conform, and inadequate resources
- Checklist requirements are being categorized as required for core requirements and recommended for less
  critical items that could be aspired to for better performance, but not required for conformance
  - Mr. O'Donnell suggested the option of two checklists with these categories to streamline the process
  - There are many permutations / combinations of ways that data are collected, and BC leaders would like to simplify this process without limiting possible combinations
  - Several of the current checklists were reviewed as examples of what would qualify as "required" versus those qualifying as "recommended"
- Easing the burden for sites, especially those with many scanners, e.g., 50 or more, would be appreciated, as it would be difficult for sites to conform otherwise
  - o Cost and logistics barriers to site conformance exist, including the use and shipment of phantoms
- Finding the sweet spot between the high and low bar for conformance is the goal
  - Dropping certain important requirements may degrade Claim performance and must be carefully considered
- Dr. Chauhan also recommended consulting hepatologists regarding quality standards
