Review of Latest Version of Profile-writing Group Support Guide

- Target audience is societies and organizations seeking to support the further development and dissemination of QIBA Profiles following the QIBA transition to QUIC
- The Profile-writing process including literature review, groundwork projects, streamlined Profile template, checklist vetting requirements, stage advancement is described

PC Feedback Included:

- Wording changes in Biomarker Committees section overview of BCs, including their purpose, products, and composition
- Section title change to "Secretariat Responsibilities and BC Logistics"
 - Defines length of Profile-writing group member commitment as likely 2 3 years, depending on factors,
 e.g., Profile stage, available groundwork data, statistical support, volunteer availability, etc.
 - Includes suggested meeting frequency, format, and purpose and meeting-related tasks, e.g., meeting summaries/action items, tracking call attendance for voting privileges, etc.
- Profile Promotion Outreach subsection was added to the Stage Advancement section along with text regarding white paper reports, instructions on accessing QIBA EndNote collections via the QIBA Wiki <u>Education page</u>, conference presentations / talks, regular informational emails, etc.
- Existing resources, e.g., QIBA Wiki, Profile library, Profile guidance documents, Google docs, archive of shared documents, were listed
 - o RSNA staff to post Profiles that meet QUIC endorsement criteria to the Wiki
 - Suggestion that Profile Writing Group leaders or society admin support contacts create Wiki accounts to maintain their pages
