QIBA fMRI/DICOM WG 16 (Dr. Reuss)

- Summary of results from meeting with DC WG 16 was reviewed
 - Feedback from WG 16 to be incorporated prior to the November mtg
 - Dr. Reuss has prepared a brief summary for the manufacturers and vendors
 - Drs. Reuss and Elsinger anticipate additional fMRI Tech Ctte participants and contacts from the FDA as a result of this meeting, and would like to discuss the enhanced MR effort at the face-to-face mtg in November
- Mr. Lenoski suggested that the fMRI Tech Ctte needs an expert contributor with specific MR knowledge
- Dr. Voyvodic commented that some software developers may begin developing tools for implementing and reading fMRI DICOM images

Profile Draft Progress (Drs. Elsinger / Mohamed)

- Draft of the Profile to be circulated for discussion prior to the Nov. 2nd call.
- Any changes in claims need to be reflected on the poster. There was some concern regarding the vague nature of the claims; however, these presently include use case, clinical case, and tentative claims, and are structured in a procedural and methodological method
 - As the group continues to generate studies for fMRI as a biomarker, supporting data will be needed for FDA qualification
