Review of Previous Meeting Summary

Topics Discussed:

- Update on Dr. Voyvodic's reproducibility study
- Section 4 Assessment Procedures

Next Steps / Action Items:

- Dr. Voyvodic's reproducibility study takeaways included the following:
 - Analysis indicated that Peak activation (t value) was the best indicator of good data quality, with stability across both language-mapping and motor-mapping scans
 - Number of active voxels (or size of activation) was an acceptable indicator of data quality
 - o Whole brain at peak is the best parameter and is simple to calculate
- 3.7 Technologist scan parameters to be moved to "fMRI Specialist"
- 4.1 Assessment Procedure: "fMRI Center-of-Mass Reproducibility" was updated to "fMRI Location Reproducibility"
- DROs to be created for 4.1 and 4.2 Assessment Procedure: fMRI Laterality Index Reproducibility to help site to assess whether Claim is on target
 - o DROs to be added to the QIDW and link to be added to Profile
 - When a Profile has not yet advanced to Claim-Confirmed (stage 4), sites will need to perform test-retest reproducibility scans to make sure that their data match the Claims
 - The BC will need to perform the assessment procedure to advance to stage 4 and demonstrate that their Claims are on target
 - fMRI BC members were invited to analyze DROs
- fMRI BC Co-chair to attend <u>Feb. 15 Process Cmte meeting</u> to provide feedback on experience using the new Profile template; Zoom details to be forwarded
