# **Review of Previous Call Summary**

#### **Public Comment Resolution Process**

- Public Comment Round 1 resolutions document to be reformatted into the <u>Google Sheets template</u> for inclusion on the <u>Comment Resolutions</u> page on the QIBA Wiki
- The DWI Public Comment Round 2 resolutions document will be finalized and posted soon

# **Planning for Stage 3: Technical Confirmation**

- Goal is to attain consensus status within the next 1-2 months, then pursue Technical Confirmation
- Profiles undergo the entire <u>review process</u> at each stage of development requiring BC and CC voting
  - o BC/CC to send feedback to staff
  - The main purpose of BC approval is to confirm that all the detailed contents are correct and the profile meets the <u>criteria for the stage</u>
  - The main purpose of CC approval is oversight to confirm that the Profile claim is on target and to bring fresh eyes to the overall document
- An overview of the <u>Technical Confirmation process</u> was provided
- Discussion re: complexity presented by including multiple organs with different protocols; <u>approach</u> to <u>Stage 3:</u>
   <u>Technically Confirmed</u> needed
  - o Technical confirmation is a crucial Profile stage to be considered for clinical trial use
  - Agreement that feasibility surveys should be conducted at DWI BC member institutions familiar with the
     Profile
  - Recommendation that BC member sites who have expertise in each organ system should be used
    - All four organs to be covered across several sites, each focusing on one or two (assessing all four organs not necessary for each site)
    - All vendor platforms to be included
    - According to the criteria for <u>Stage 3: Technically Confirmed</u>, Profile procedures and requirements to be performed/checked on <u>at least two vendor platforms and at two or more sites</u>...
  - Clarification needed re: whether feasibility testing (survey) needs to include a phantom and/or human subject scanning; Dr. Boss to bring this question to an upcoming Process Cmte call
  - Suggestion to evaluate content on <u>Profile Stages</u> and <u>Technical Confirmation Process</u> QIBA Wiki pages;
     fleshing out more process detail may be helpful
  - Suggestion made to use sites w/o a QIBA connection to DWI BC (fresh eyes)

- Suggestion to duplicate Profile use in a real-world clinical trial scenario by conducting feasibility surveys at sites not already familiar with the DWI Profile; topic to be raised with MR CC, Process Cmte, and eventually SC meetings
- Technical confirmation process to be discussed during the Dec. 4 QIBA Working Meeting MR CC breakout session
- Aim to begin the technical confirmation process in early 2020

### **DWI-MR Profile Review: Resolve Final Issues**

- 3.6.1: Profile Activities Discussion Section
  - Mention of k-space undersampling was added to the Profile and DWI-MR BC consensus re: references
     (DWI reduced k-space, rFOV, multi-shot) to include was sought
    - Articles on list submitted by Dr. Wilmes were reviewed for inclusion in the Profile
    - All articles to be added to DWI EndNote collection
    - Suggestions for references on liver should be submitted to Dr. Boss
- 3.11 / 3.11.1: Image QA/Discussion Section
  - References and texts for SNR evaluations in 3.11.1 and Appendix E were discussed
  - o References to NEMA standard from 2015 to be removed
  - o Updates made by Drs. Chenevert and Malyarenko accepted as final

#### **Next Steps**

- Dr. Boss to make final Profile updates and send it to staff for DWI BC circulation by Oct. 10
- SME assignments for Profile review of specific sections to be made
- Both rounds of public comment resolution to be compiled and posted on the <u>Comment Resolutions QIBA Wiki</u>
   page
- A BC vote-to-publish the DWI-MR Profile as Stage 2: Consensus to be initiated upon completion of the BC internal review process; the goal is to complete both BC and CC voting by **early November** 
  - To proceed with a vote-to-publish, Drs. Boss and Chenevert to simply confirm that the Profile is ready and request staff send an e-ballot to eligible BC voting members
  - o Email ballot will then be sent to eligible BC voters, with a separate notification to inform non-voters
