### Profile Updates and Outstanding Items Reviewed (Mr. O'Donnell)

- Explanatory statements related to product validation for better clarity
- Protocol conformance statements now more specific
- Disclaimer language still under consideration
  - Different scenarios for on-label vs. off-label use may need to be considered
  - Presently, no specific instructions are in place for QIBA protocols regarding non-labeled vendor devices
  - This is a new area for exploration
- Phantom-based validation procedures to test the protocol
  - Group to determine whether these should be added for this edition or for future editions of the Profile
- Data upload to QIDW has been completed; however, data are still being tweaked
- Dr. Petrick is working on compiling the .csv file for the 'Lungman' data bundle
- Final outreach to contributing authors: Dr. Goldmacher to draft email to those who have not responded, asking for a definitive response
- Final additions to the authorship list to be added by Mr. O'Donnell
- Reminder that the CT CC voting members will need to approve Profile release via e-ballot when ready
