- Standardized B1 mapping and flip angle sequences available on everyday scanners are needed, as well as a software solution for correcting Ktrans for T1 and B1; Dr. Laue to reach out to vendors

- Drs. Laue and Lavini to meet offline before the next meeting
- Dr. Laue to prepare a more detailed agenda for the next meeting and invite Dr. Chung
