## RedCap and QIDW Update

- Drs. Samir and Dyhani are using the research registry, "<u>RedCap</u>" to store data obtained from the standardized case report forms, as well as the forms themselves
- The form can also be used off-line, as data can be saved via Excel and later uploaded to RedCap
  - o An Excel form can be downloaded from the RedCap site for tracking data from the case report forms
- RedCap will be used in conjunction with QIDW: RedCap will be used to store the clinical data from the case report forms, and QIDW will host the clinical images
  - It is hoped that there may be a way to link the two together, creating a coveted research tool usable beyond the QIBA community
  - Dr. Dhyani to investigate any related user-costs for external institutions to use RedCap
  - Dr. Dhyani to invite the QIBA US SWS Clinical Subcommittee members to the RedCap database community (similarly to Dropbox) to assess this research tool
- Some benefits of using RedCap to store the case-report forms are as follows:
  - o Incremental automatic backups allow you to restore data to a certain point in time if an error is made
  - o Forms are 'living' documents and can easily be updated
  - Use of forms is simplified, due to buttons, scroll bars, etc. that allow for ease of use
  - Multiple free tools via the consortium are available on RedCap

#### **Action items:**

- Dr. Dhyani to investigate whether there is a cost for external institutions to use RedCap
- Dr. Dhyani to invite the QIBA US SWS Clinical Subcommittee members to the RedCap database community
