- DSC-MRI BC updates added to Dashboard, e.g., manuscripts (finalizing edits in White paper and DSC phantom paper), presentations, link to Dr. Erickson's DROs
- Review of DSC-MRI White paper draft to be submitted to Radiology
- Developing a cross-sectional Claim in the DSC-MRI Profile for clinical implementation

Action items

- Steps for including a cross-sectional Claim in the DSC-MRI Profile for clinical implementation
 - o Individual clinical patient data are needed to determine the standard deviation of AUC-TN (rCBV) values within an individual ROI in a single patient to:
 - Estimate within a subject a truly abnormal AUC-TN value with respect to contralateral hemisphere as well as in the enhancing tumor
 - Determine amount of change in rCBV values needed to be 95% confident of true abnormality
 - Repeatability precision value would need to be determined
 - To determine true change, the variability in the values among the voxels from a single scan and a single subject would need to be known
 - Dr. Shiroishi to request original spreadsheets from Dr. Schmainda to determine what the minimum volume should be, e.g., x voxel
 - Dr. Wu to download <u>The Cancer Imaging Archive (TCIA)</u> datasets to determine whether there are clinical DSC data with pre- and post-GABA T1
- Staff to provide DSC-MRI roster with attendance details for White Paper Acknowledgments section
- White Paper to be circulated among co-authors once references are finalized and word count is reduced (target date is by Oct. 31)
